

PARENTAL CONSENT TO TRAVEL FOR MINORS TRAVELING OUTSIDE THE U.S.

A person under the age of 18 traveling without a legal guardian may be asked by the airline for notarized evidence of parental consent to travel when entering or leaving the United States and other countries.

HOW TO USE THIS FORM:

- Print and complete the next page. Note that the form must be signed in the presence of a notary public.
- VISIONS does not require this form, but we recommend it because airlines may request it.
- This form is *only* needed by minors who leave their country of residence for a program.
- **Do not mail this form to VISIONS.** It should be in your child's carry-on bag as they travel.
- Don't wait until the last minute—the form must be signed and **notarized**.
